

# How to Pray for the Volunteers and Internationals

1. **God's Glory and Kingdom** – please pray:
  - a. That God's name will be revered, that His kingdom will come, and that His will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10)
  - b. That the whole earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Hab. 2:14)
  - c. That we may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, (Col. 1:9)
  - d. That we will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, (1:10)
  - e. That we will bear fruit in every good work, (1:10)
  - f. That we will increase in the knowledge of God, (1:10)
  - g. That we will be strengthened with all power, ...joyously giving thanks to the Father. (1:11-12)
  
2. **Spiritual Warfare** – please pray:
  - a. That we will be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might, and that we will always put on the full armor of God, so that we will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. (Eph. 6:10, 11).
  - b. That the Lord will rescue us from temptation and deliver us from evil. (2 Pet. 2:9, Matt. 6:13)
  - c. That we will not neglect our devotions, but that we will seek the Lord with all our heart, treasuring His word in our heart and lifting our voices to Him. (Psalm 119:10, 11; 5:3)
  
3. **Sharing the Good News** – please pray:
  - a. That God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ (Col. 4:3)
  - b. That we may make the gospel clear in the way we ought to speak (4:4)
  - c. That we will conduct ourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity.(4:5)
  - d. That our speech will always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that we will know how we should respond to each person. (4:6)
  - e. That the Lord will grant us to continue to speak his word with all boldness, while He stretches out his hand to heal and perform signs and wonder through the name of Jesus (Acts 4:29-30)
  
4. **The Internationals** – please pray:
  - a. That our light will shine before them in such a way that they will see our good works, and glorify our Father who is in heaven. (Matt. 5:16).
  - b. That God will give them a new heart and spirit, and that He will take the heart of stone out of their flesh and give them a heart of flesh. (Ez. 11:19)
  - c. That the Father will draw them to Jesus (Jn. 6:44)
  - d. That they will confess with their mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in their heart that God raised Him from the dead (Rom.10:9)
  - e. That they will become disciples, baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, observing all that Jesus has commanded us (Matt. 28:19-20).
  - f. That they will go home to their friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for them, and how He has had mercy on them, thus leading more to Jesus (Mark 5:19)
